ORDINANCE NO.: 03-01

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING A TWO THOUSAND DOLLAR FINE FOR ANY PERSON WHO DISPOSES AN ANIMAL CARCASS ALONGSIDE A PUBLIC ROAD, PUBLIC RIGHT OF WAY, OR PUBLIC PROPERTY; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE THEREIN.

WHEREAS, there are many acres of land within Liberty County that are hunted during hunting season; and

WHEREAS, several complaints have been received that during hunting season animal carcasses are left alongside public roads, public right of ways, or on public property

WHEREAS, the animal carcasses that are left alongside public roads, public right of ways, or on public property are visually disturbing to the public and also create unsanitary conditions; and

WHEREAS, no person has any legal authority or right to dump an animal carcass alongside a public road, public right of way, or on public property;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF LIBERTY COUNTY, FLORIDA:

1. This Ordinance establishes a two thousand dollar (\$2,000) fine for any person who disposes of an animal carcass alongside a public road, public right of way, or on public property.

2. This Ordinance shall take effect as provided by law.
