ORDINANCE NO.: 07-07

AN ORDINANCE OF LIBERTY COUNTY, FLORIDA, DESIGNATING THE 120 MILE PER HOUR LINE WIND-BORNE DEBRIS REGION FOR LIBERTY COUNTY; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE THEREIN.

WHEREAS, the Florida Legislature has required through the Florida Building Code that if the 120 mile per hour line known as the Wind-Borne Debris Region line flows through a county, then that county must pass an Ordinance designating such area as the Wind-Borne Debris Region; and

WHEREAS, according to the map contained in Florida Building Code Section 1609.3, the 120 mile per hour line Wind-Borne Region does travel through a portion of Liberty County.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of County Commissioners of Liberty County, Florida, that:

1. The 120 mile per hour Wind-Borne Region for Liberty County, Florida, is south of the following described boundary:

That Greenback Lake is the point of beginning of the Southwest wind speed zone. From Greenback Lake travel west to east down Forest Road 113 to Wilma, Florida, then from Wilma on Forest Road 13 across to Twinpoles Hunting Camp, which intersects there with Forest Road 170, then go south to Mud Swamp and New River, intersect there with Forest Road 83 over to Gum Bay, then precede southeast across Gum Bay and Forest Road 125 and Thousand Yard Bay to the point of ending, which is Sand Born Lake and County Road 22.

2. Any land that falls south of the above described property shall be designated as within the 120 mph Wind-Borne Debris Region for Liberty County.
3. This Ordinance shall take effect as provided by law.
