ORDINANCE NO. 92 - 04

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING LIBERTY COUNTY ORDINANCE NO. 87-03 SO AS TO AUTHORIZE THE USE OF COUNTY EQUIPMENT AND LABOR, AT COST, TO REMOVE THE REMAINDER OF HOMES AND OTHER DEBRIS ASSOCIATED WITH SAID HOMES WHICH ARE DESTROYED BY FIRE, WIND, OR OTHER FORM OF CASUALTY; PROVIDING FOR CONFLICT AND SEVERABILITY; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of Liberty County, Florida hereby finds and determines that it is necessary for the health and welfare of the citizens of Liberty County, Florida, to provide for the removal by the County, at cost, of the remainder of homes and other debris associated with said homes, which are destroyed by fire, wind, or other forms of casualty;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF LIBERTY COUNTY, FLORIDA that:

Section 1. Amendments to Ordinance. Liberty County Ordinance No. 87-03 is hereby amended to delete the present **Section 3. Effective Date**, and add the following new sections:

Section 3. Removal of Remains of Homes and Other Debris. The Board of County Commissioners of Liberty County, Florida, when requested to do so by a homeowner, is hereby authorized to use county equipment and labor, at cost, to remove the remainder of homes and other debris associated with said homes, which are destroyed by fire, wind or other forms of casualty, provided the cost thereof, referred to in Section 4 hereof, is paid to Liberty County in advance.

Section 4. Determination of Charges for the Services Provided for in Section One of this Amendment. The Board of County Commissioners of Liberty County, Florida shall determine a charge to be made for the use of county equipment and labor, which charge shall be the cost to Liberty County, Florida, for the furnishing of such equipment and labor.

Section 5. Conflict. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with the provisions of this amended Ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

Section 6. Severability. If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase or portion of this amended Ordinance is for any reason held invalid or unconstitutional by any court of competent jurisdiction, such portion shall be deemed a separate, distinct, and independent provision, and such holding shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this Ordinance.

Section 7. Effective Date. This amended Ordinance shall take effect as provided by law.
