**ORDINANCE NO.: 03-02**

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NUMBER 03-01; ESTABLISHING THE MAXIMUM FINE PROVIDED BY LAW FOR ANY PERSON WHO DISPOSES OF AN ANIMAL CARCASS ALONGSIDE A PUBLIC ROAD, PUBLIC RIGHT OF WAY, OR PUBLIC PROPERTY; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE THEREIN.**

**WHEREAS**, there are many acres of land within Liberty County that are hunted during hunting season; and

**WHEREAS**, several complaints have been received that during hunting season animal carcasses are left alongside public roads, public right of ways, or on public property;

**WHEREAS**, the animal carcasses that are left alongside public roads, public right of ways, or on public property are visually disturbing to the public and also create unsanitary conditions; and

**WHEREAS**, no person has any legal authority or right to dump an animal carcass alongside a public road, public right of way, or on public property;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF LIBERTY COUNTY, FLORIDA:**

1. This Ordinance establishes the maximum fine provided by law for any person who disposes of an animal carcass alongside a public road, public right of way, or on public property.
2. This Ordinance shall take effect as provided by law.
