

An Ordinance to be entitled:

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS TO USE COUNTY EQUIPMENT AND LABOR FOR IMPROVEMENTS AND MAINTENANCE OF PUBLIC CEMETERIES, PUBLIC SCHOOL GROUNDS, SIMILAR PUBLIC PLACES WITHOUT COMPENSATION THEREFOR AND FOR IMPROVEMENTS AND MAINTENANCE OF CERTAIN ROAD EXTENSIONS AND DRIVEWAYS, SAID EQUIPMENT TO BE USED AND FURNISHED FOR SUCH PURPOSES WITHOUT CHARGE THEREFOR OR FOR SUCH CHARGES AS THE BOARD MAY DEEM PROPER; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

This Ordinance is adopted pursuant to authority conferred on the Board of County Commissioners by Chapter 125, Florida Statutes.

PURPOSE

The purpose of this Ordinance, among other things, is to clarify and legalize prior actions of the Board of County Commissioners with respect to the subject matter stated above that they have previously been applied pursuant to Chapter 59-605, Florida Statutes, now repealed by Chapter 71-29.

SECTION I

The Board of County Commissioners of Liberty County, Florida, is hereby authorized to use County equipment and labor for the improvement and maintenance of any cemetery used by the general public and without cost or charge; for the improvement and maintenance of any free public school yard or grounds, and similar public places, said equipment and labor to be used and furnished for such purposes without charge therefor, or for such charges as the Board shall deem proper; and, further, may use such equipment and labor when requested to do so for improvement and maintenance of any road extensions and driveways, provided a charge may be made for such equipment and labor of not less than the cost to said County for the furnishing of such equipment and labor for such purposes.

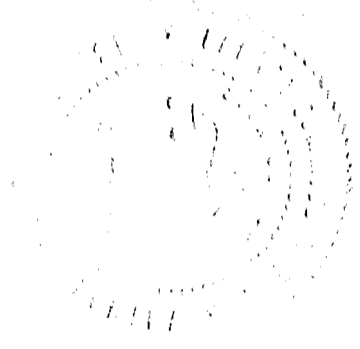
SECTION II

If any section, sub-section, sentence or clause, phrase or portion of this Ordinance is for any reason held invalid or unconstitutional by any Court of competent jurisdiction, such a portion shall be deemed a separate, distinct and independent provision and such holding shall not affect the validity of the remaining portion of this Ordinance.

SECTION III

This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon being filed with the Florida Secretary of State.
