LIBERTY COUNTY ORDINANCE NO. 97- 04

AN ORDINANCE REPEALING LIBERTY COUNTY ORDINANCE NO. 97-03, COMMONLY REFERRED TO AS THE ELECTRIC UTILITY PRIVILEGE FEE ORDINANCE; PROVIDING DEFINITIONS; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF LIBERTY COUNTY, FLORIDA:

SECTION 1. DEFINITIONS. When used in this ordinance, the capitalized terms shall have the same meanings as set forth in Liberty County Ordinance No. 97-03.

SECTION 2. REPEAL OF ORDINANCE NO. 97-03.

(A) On August 12, 1997, the County adopted Ordinance No. 97-03, granting certain rights and privileges to Electric Utilities that operate in the unincorporated areas of the County and imposing an Electric Utility Privilege Fee on all those Electric Utilities at 5.5 percent of their Gross Revenues generated in the unincorporated areas. Ordinance No. 97-03 became effective on August 17, 1997, upon its filing with the Secretary of State.

(B) The Board hereby repeals Liberty County Ordinance No. 97-03 in its entirety.

(C) The Clerk is hereby directed to return any and all revenue received from any Electric Utility pursuant to Ordinance No. 97-03. Accordingly, no Electric Utility shall make any Electric Utility Privilege Fee payment to the County after the effective date of this ordinance.




