ORDINANCE NO.: 03-01

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING A TWO THOUSAND DOLLAR FINE FOR ANY PERSON WHO DISPOSES AN ANIMAL CARCASS ALONGSIDE A PUBLIC ROAD, PUBLIC RIGHT OF WAY, OR PUBLIC PROPERTY; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE THEREIN.

WHEREAS, there are many acres of land within Liberty County that are hunted during hunting season; and

WHEREAS, several complaints have been received that during hunting season animal carcasses are left alongside public roads, public right of ways, or on public property

- VALEREAS, the animal carcasses that are left alongside public roads, public right of vays, or on public property are visually disturbing to the public and also create unsanitar a conditions; and
- V **EREAS, no person has any legal authority or right to dump an animal carcass attengside a public road, public right of way, or on public property;
 - NAW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY CAMMISSIONERS OF LIBERTY COUNTY, FLORIDA:

This Ordinance establishes a two thousand dollar (\$2,000) fine for any person who disposes of an animal carcass alongside a public road, public right of way, or on public property.

This Ordinance shall take effect as provided by law.
