ORDINANCE NO. 91-

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCES NOS.79-1 AND 81-2 RELATING TO THE WATER DISTRIBUTION SYSTEM PROVIDED BY LIBERTY COUNTY, FLORIDA; PROVIDING FOR A NAME OF THE WATER SYSTEM; PROVIDING FOR THE USE OF COUNTY WATER, ESTABLISHING RATES TO BE CHARGED FOR THE USE OF COUNTY WATER, ESTABLISHING RULES, REGULATIONS AND PENALTIES; PROVIDING MEANS FOR ENFORCEMENT OF PAYMENT FOR WATER SERVICES; PROVIDING REQUIREMENTS FOR CONNECTION TO SAID COUNTY WATER SYSTEM, SETTING UP MAINTENANCE REQUIREMENTS; PROHIBITING FREE WATER SERVICE; PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATION OF THIS ORDINANCE AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, subsequent to Ordinance No. 79-1 establishing a water distribution system in Hosford and Telogia, the Board of County Commissioners of Liberty County, Florida has provided for a water distribution system in Esteffanulga and Sumatra; and

WHEREAS, the name of the water distribution system as provided in Ordinance No. 79-1 is the "Hosford-Telogia Water Distribution System"; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of Liberty County, Florida desires to change the name of the water system.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of County Commissioners of Liberty County, Florida, as follows:

<u>Section 1</u>. The water distribution system provided for Hosford, Telogia, Sumatra, Estaffanulga and any other water systems in Liberty County in the future provided by the Board of County Commissioners of Liberty County, Florida shall be known as the "Liberty Water System."

<u>Section 2.</u> <u>Conflict.</u> All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

Section 3. Severability. If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase or portion of this Ordinance is for any reason held invalid or unconstitutional by any court of competent jurisdiction, such portion shall be deemed separate, distinct, and independent provision, and such holding shall

not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this Ordinance.

Section 4. Effective Date. In accordance with Section 125.66, Florida Statutes, a certified copy of this Ordinance shall be filed with the Department of State by the Clerk of the Board of County Commissioners within ten (10) days after enactment, and this Ordinance shall take effect upon receipt of official acknowledgement that said Ordinance has been filed.
