

**Notice of Public Comments and Intent to Apply for CDBG-DR Grant Funds
Rebuild Florida Hazard Mitigation Grant Match Program**

Liberty County, Florida anticipates applying for Rebuild Florida Hazard Mitigation Grant Match Program Funding in the maximum amount of \$131,365.50 provided by the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) Community Development Block Grant – Disaster Recovery (CDBG-DR) allocation for Hurricane Michael to reimburse the non-federal portion of an awarded and eligible Hazard Mitigation Grant Program (HMGP) grant. Funding will be administered by the Florida Department of Economic Opportunity (DEO).

This public notice is to solicit citizen comments on the proposed project. The public comment period begins August 17, 2021 and ends on September 1, 2021. The public hearing will be held on September 1, 2021 at the Liberty County Emergency Operations Center located at 10979 NW Spring Street, Bristol, Florida. The public hearing starts at 2:00 PM EST.

Liberty County has selected the project that best meets the requirements of both the HMGP and the CDBG-DR Hazard Mitigation Grant Match Program.

Project: Generators for Critical Facilities in Liberty County (Cost to Liberty County \$0.00)

The Generators will be in place to provide a secondary source of power to the following locations:

- EMS Generator
- Sheriff's Office Generator
- Road Department Generator
- Special Needs Shelter Generator

In total, DEO has allocated \$109 million dollars in CDBG-DR funds to the HMGP Match Program.
